Students who wish to be considered for this prize are encouraged to submit supporting material according to the price regulations located on the web site of IAAC - the Israeli Association for Automatic Control at http://iaac.technion.ac.il/education/VelgerPrizeRules.pdf.

The success of the event depends on the participation of both the students and the faculty members, and I hope that you and your students will be able to join us.
