As always, the event will include awarding of the Velger prize for an outstanding graduate student work. The prize has been established jointly by IAAC and El-Op company in memorial of the late Dr. Marko Velger, a distinguished member of the Israeli control community. Students who wish to be considered for the prize should submit no later than April 3, 2016, in addition to the above, a letter of recommendation from their thesis superviser. They may (but do not have to) submit any material (e.g. a paper) which they consider relevant to the case. Candidates for the Velger prize are eligible only if they stay the whole day, from first to last lecture.
