Please include "GSC 2021 submission" as email subject line. The material must be submitted in English (plain text). Priority, if needed, will be given to presentations reporting on final stages of the research, and to GSC newcomers.

As in past years, the GSC Award will be conferred to an outstanding paper presented at the workshop. The advisers who wish their students to be considered for this award are encouraged to submit supporting material according to the regulations located on the web site of IAAC—the Israeli Association for Automatic Control at: <u>http://iaac.technion.ac.il/education/GSCAwardRules.pdf</u>
