1. author information: a list of all authors, including affiliations and contact details,

- 2. title: could include stand-alone LATEX code,
- 3. abstract: up to 250 words, stand-alone LATEX code allowed,
- 4. keywords: up to 5 keywords related to the paper's content. Submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the organizing committee. The organizing committee will notify the authors regarding the acceptance of the abstract and the presentation format (oral or interactive).
